

Puerto Rico Hurricane Survivor Service Referral Guide

This referral guide was created to Coordinate Services for Puerto Rico Hurricane Survivors entering WNY. It was created based on the resources we identified in the Community to address their immediate needs. The first page is meant to capture basic information about the individuals that can be used by the providers listed to assist them (but it is not needed for them to be assisted). It includes an attestation that can be signed by their family or service provider identifying them as a displaced Hurricane Survivor in need of immediate assistance for providers that require that verification in order to assist. It has a check list of resources with the information needed to access them.
