WHEREAS, the City of Buffalo New York is a tapestry of many cultures, each with its own traditions, woven together to form the heart and soul of our community; and






WHEREAS, the various Hispanic organizations within the community will celebrate Hispanic Heritage Month with the full cooperation and support of many business in Erie County New York;


