- **WHEREAS,** the Hispanic population throughout Western New York is approximately 70,000 people with concentrations of the population residing in Buffalo's Lower West Side, South Buffalo, and Lackawanna; and
- **WHEREAS,** the opening ceremony is designed to raise public awareness about the richness and diversity of Latin American culture as well as encourage area residents to participate in the variety of Hispanic heritage events during Hispanic Heritage Month;
